The Hope of Our Prayer

Psalm 85; Luke 11:1-13

We will have the pleasure this Sunday of welcoming to our pulpit the Rev. Gina "Pastor T" Colorio. Her sermon "The Hope of Our Prayer" will reflect Psalm 85 and Luke 11: 1-13. Rev. Gina and her husband are parents to 10 children (7 adopted, three by birth). She is a baker, outdoors enthusiast, and "grace focused". Gina considers herself a teacher at heart and believes that the "keenest revelation into the soul of any society is manifested in the manner in which they treat their children" [Nelson Mandela].

July Mission of the Month - Adoption Rhode Island

ADOPTION RHODE ISLAND is a private nonprofit organization whose mission is to create safety, belonging and permanency for adopted and foster children, vulnerable youth, and families through compassionate services, advocacy, and education.

"Celebrating 40 Years of Changing Lives for Children and Youth in Foster Care", Adoption Rhode Island delivers programs in four areas: permanency services (promoting and assisting families with foster care and adoption); behavioral health and wellness (services for foster and adopted children, adult adoptees, kinship caregivers, and adoptive parents); youth and young adult services (for ages 18-24, helping youth transition successfully and safely into adulthood), advocacy, training and technical

assistance (consultation services, student intern opportunities, specialized trainings).

DONATE A BAG! At our July 13th worship service we heard from Lise Iwon about Adoption Rhode Island and, especially, about the Duffle Bag Bash event. If you would like to donate a <u>new</u> suitcase or duffle bag, you may bring it to the church office or to the Duffle Bag Bash 8/10.

Lise says "Ten years ago, the Office of the Child Advocate (a State agency), Adoption RI (a non-profit 501C3 agency) and I (a private citizen) got together to have a fundraiser for children in State care. Why? Because kids in State care have nothing and NEED everything. And because the DCYF budget has been cut by millions of dollars, and children are falling through the cracks. And because workers are underpaid, overworked and underappreciated. And...And...And!

"Kids on night-to-night placement often carry all of their belongings in trash bags, so we started this fundraiser to eliminate trash bags as suitcases. They need money for EVERYTHING: food, shelter, clothing, transportation, sheets for their bed, EVERYTHING. I'll explain more when we are together... "

Prayer Matters



To build fellowship and make full use of the congregational power of prayer, we offer this Prayer Matters space to allow

members of our community to lift up their names and requests for prayer. This adds to the opportunities for congregants to lift up their prayers during Sunday service, and to request the care of the <u>Prayer Circle</u> that gathers every Tuesday morning or of our Called to Care ministry.

How to share your prayer

You may choose to use all or any combination of: Joys & Concerns on Sunday morning, Prayer Circle ministry, Called to Care ministry, and the new Prayer Matters section of the newsletter.

- To lift up your prayer during Sunday Service, simply raise your hand, voice your joy or concern and then say, "this is my prayer"; the congregation responds "this is our prayer". Prayer requests made during Sunday service are shared aloud with those in attendance.
- To request the care of **Prayer Circle**, submit the online form or call the church office at (401) 789-7313. These requests are shared only with members of this group.
- To request the support of our **Called to Care** ministry team, call the church office at (401) 789-7313 or submit the online form. These requests are shared only with members of this group.
- To request your prayer be included in the E-Light newsletter, send email to office@peacedalechurch.org or call the church office at (401) 789-7313 (leave message for MaryLou).
